Championship History:

First played in 1998, the SA Junior Masters instigated as a boy's event. In 2011, the girl's event was introduced and played in conjunction. The event is played over 72 holes stroke play at Royal Adelaide Golf Club and has seen winners such as Adam Scott, Marc Leishman and Jason Day. The event is both an Australian Junior Order of Merit & Junior World Ranking event played over 72 holes of stroke play.

Course Information:

The Seaton course, widely acknowledged as ranking with the best in Australia, is in Adelaide's western suburbs, less than 20-minute drive from the city and less than two km's from the coast.

Despite many alterations made since the first blow was struck in 1906, it retains its distinctive character of a comparatively open links course, an attribute by no means common in this country.

Registration:

All players are requested to report to the registration area prior to their tee time on Thursday 9th January and Friday 10th January. Registration will be located outside under the verandah near the putting green.

Withdrawals:

Any player wishing to withdraw from the Championship should contact Leah Tattersall on 0403 543 817 or leaht@golf.org.au. Any entrant may withdraw and have the entrance fee refunded provided notification is received prior to the draw being made available on Thursday 2nd January 2020.

Results & Draws:

The Round 1 & 2 draw for Thursday will be made available on Thursday 2nd January. A seeded draw for Round 3 & 4 will be made available following the conclusion of play on Thursday. The draw will be available on the Golf Australia website – www.golf.org.au/golfsa

Practice Round:

Practice rounds are available from 2pm on Tuesday 7th or Wednesday 8th January at a cost of \$70. Please make a booking by phoning the Royal Adelaide Pro Shop on (08) 8356 8508. Competitors must have registered for the Championship before making a practice round booking.

Practice Facilities and Balls:

Practice facilities will be available to players only on the days of the competition. Entry fee includes 1 x bucket of balls per player, per day. Additional range balls will be available for purchase from the Professional Shop at a cost of \$6 per bucket.

Pull Buggies:

Pull buggy hire is included in the entry fee. Buggies must be returned to the Professional Shop area on completion of round and not left at front/ side of clubhouse.

Distance Measuring Devices/GPS:

Distance measuring devices are permitted for this Championship.

Course Guides:

Course Guides are available from the Royal Adelaide Pro Shop at a cost of \$25.

Ready Golf:

The Championship is a "Ready Golf" event. "Ready Golf" should be played, but in a safe and responsible way. Play when you are ready – you don't have to wait until the farthest away players has played. E.g. play Ready Golf

- When the player farther away has a difficult shot and is assessing options
- When a longer hitter has to wait for the green to clear
- On the tee if a player with the honor is delayed
- By playing your shot before helping to look for a lost ball

Dress Requirements:

Players and caddies are required to comply with the club rules. Neat, tidy dress is essential, and shirt must have a collar. No Jeans. Tailored shorts may be worn. If wearing short socks, they must be plain white or your club's white socks with logo.

Catering:

Players lunch (baguette) is included each day. The Members Bar will be available from sunrise daily.

Mobile Phones:

Mobile phones may be used on the golf course during competition to access a distance measuring device application or to call for a ruling only.

Golf Australia Hard Card:

The Golf Australia Hard Card will be in effect throughout the Championship and will be provided to players at registration.

Course Care:

All clubs which host Golf Australia events kindly give up their course for the duration of the event. Hence, so that the course is left in a suitable condition once the Championship is completed, players MUST carry AND use a sand bucket and repair ALL pitch marks. Any player seen to be in breach of this request may face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.

Clubhouse and Gate Access:

The club gates will close from 7.00pm each night with no outside vehicle entry after this time.

Hot Weather Guidelines:

January in Adelaide *can* be very hot. Players must carry adequate water and wear appropriate clothing. In the case of hot weather, Tournament Officials in a motorised cart will provide additional water stations for players at various intervals at no charge.
