TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

- 1. The competition shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course at the time the competition is played.
- 2. TWO teams per club may be entered, if field capacity allows. In the instance that the number of entries exceeds the maximum field capacity, entries will be returned and refunded. Unsuccessful entries will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals occur.
- 3. Entrance fees must be paid at the time of entry.
- 4. The event is open to any female amateur player holding an official Golf Australia handicap. Please make sure you have your correct and current G.A handicap on the day.
- 5. The Match Committee shall have the power to limit the number of entries which will be received in the event, and have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 6. The Match Committee has the power to alter or make any variation to the conditions should they deem it so desirable.
- 7. The Match Committee may in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, shorten the contest or fix another day.
- 8. The Match Committee will settle any dispute or protest. Any protest must be lodged in writing with the Match Committee on the day of play.
- 9. In the event of a tie, the winner shall be decided by a count-back as per the Golf Australia count-back method.
- 10. Mobile phones may be carried for emergencies, but must be switched off during play. Electronic devices can be used to measure distance only.
- 11. Golf carts are permissible. A doctor's certificate is NOT required. Please book your cart on the space provided on the entry form.
- 12. Three (3) wheel ride-on-carts are NOT permitted to be used at Bay Views Golf Course.
- PLEASE NOTE: Any player wishing to use their own cart or ride-on-buggy must receive permission from the Bay Views Golf Course Manager or staff - Phone 5981
