### History of the Junior Victorian Open:

### Format:

72-Hole Stroke

### Times:

Monday 16 December	Round 1 – Barwon Heads	18 holes stroke	AM & PM tee times
Tuesday 17 December	Round 2 – 13 <sup>th</sup> Beach (Creek Course)	18 holes stroke	AM & PM tee times
Wednesday 18 December	Round 3 – 13 <sup>th</sup> Beach (Beach Course)	18 holes stroke	AM & PM tee times
Thursday 19 December	Round 4 – 13 <sup>th</sup> Beach (Beach Course)	18 holes stroke	AM & PM tee times

### Registration:

All players are requested to report to the registration desk at least 30 minutes prior to the tee time of each round to be allocated scorecards and temporary local rules.

### Results & Draws:

The Round 1 & 2 draws will be made available approximately 1 week prior to the event.

There is no 'cut'; all players will contest all four rounds of the Championships. However, after 36 and 54-holes the draw will be reseeded with the leading players competing in the afternoon field. The draws will be made available on the Golf Australia website at [www.golf.org.au/victoria](http://www.golf.org.au/victoria) and also e-mailed to competitors, from approximately **8:00pm** on both nights.

### Trophies:

Trophies will be awarded as follows:

#### Boys:

- Overall gross winner and runner-up
- Overall net winner and runner-up
- Gross & net winners for each age group (U14 & U16)
- Gross & net runners up for each age group (U14 & U16)

#### Girls:

- Overall gross winner, runner-up
- Overall net winner, runner-up
- Gross & net winners for each age group (U14 & U16)
- Gross & net runners up for each age group (U14 & U16)



#### Lunch:

Light lunch packs will be provided for all players from 11am on each day.

#### Breakfast

13th Beach Golf Links will have breakfast available from 7:30am each day. Breakfast is at the cost of the competitor.  
Barwon Heads Golf Club will have breakfast available from 7:00am each day. Breakfast is at the cost of the competitor.

#### Practice Rounds:

##### Barwon Heads:

Complimentary practice round on Sunday 15th December after 2pm (bookings required). Practice rounds can be arranged on Thursday 12th and Friday 13th December at a cost of \$35 for juniors.

##### 13<sup>th</sup> Beach:

Complimentary practice round available after 1pm on Sunday 15th December (bookings required). Other practice rounds can be arranged at selected times prior to tournament week with regular green fee rates applicable. Please contact the golf club for availabilities and cost.

#### Range balls:

Complimentary for warm up only. May be purchased for practice after round.

#### Caddies:

Rule 10.3 is modified in this way. A player may not have a caddie during the round. Penalty for breach of Local Rule: The player gets the general penalty for each hole during which he or she is helped by a caddie. If the breach happens or continues between the two holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole.

#### Pull buggies:

Complimentary (Only limited buggies are available. Players are encouraged to bring their own).

#### Withdrawals:

Any player wishing to withdraw from the Championship should contact Tim Witherow on 03 8545 6229 or [timw@golf.org.au](mailto:timw@golf.org.au) For any on the day withdrawal, please call the tournament mobile on 0448 577 640 (Tim).

Any entrant may withdraw and have the entrance fee refunded provided notification is received within three working days of the event. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded after this date unless players can provide Golf Australia supporting documents regarding their withdrawal from the event (i.e. Medical certificate).

#### Ready Golf:

The Championship is a "Ready Golf" event. "Ready Golf" should be played, but in a safe and responsible way. Play when you are ready – you don't have to wait until the farthest away players has played. E.g. play Ready Golf

- When the player farther away has a difficult shot and is assessing options
- When a longer hitter has to wait for the green to clear
- On the tee if a player with the honor is delayed
- By playing your shot before helping to look for a lost ball

#### Dress Regulations

Please visit the relevant websites of the host clubs. All **players & caddies** are required to adhere to the Club's dress regulations with particular reference to the links above.

The following is not permitted: jeans, jean-style and cargo pants, track suits, tight stretch pants for women, brief shorts, T-shirts, singlets, shirts without collars, thongs, sandals, significant advertising on any garment, hat, or shoe.

#### Course Care / Club Regulations

Players are reminded that sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used, and pitch marks are to be repaired. Mobile phones are not to be used in the clubhouse or on the course unless in the case of an emergency or a ruling during the round. Play will be from the nominated tee markers. Any player not complying with these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the GA Code of Conduct.



#### Motorised Carts

According to GA's standard conditions of competitions, it is the responsibility of the player, if they require the use of a golf cart during the event to send a Medical Certificate and a completed copy of the Golf Australia Motorised Transport Approval Return Form for consideration by the Match Committee.

Please go to the GA website under Victorian Event Resources → GA Motorised Transport for the return form and more information. Exemption: Players aged 75 years and over do not require a Medical Certificate.

Golf carts are at the player's own expense and MUST be booked directly through Golf Australia as soon as possible. Golf carts must be paid for at the club on the day. Golf Australia cannot guarantee the use of a golf cart on any given day of play as this is subject to each host club's conditions of usage.

Note: In the event in which a limited number of carts are available, players requesting carts will be paired together. Caddies are permitted to ride in the cart with the player ONLY when sufficient carts are available.

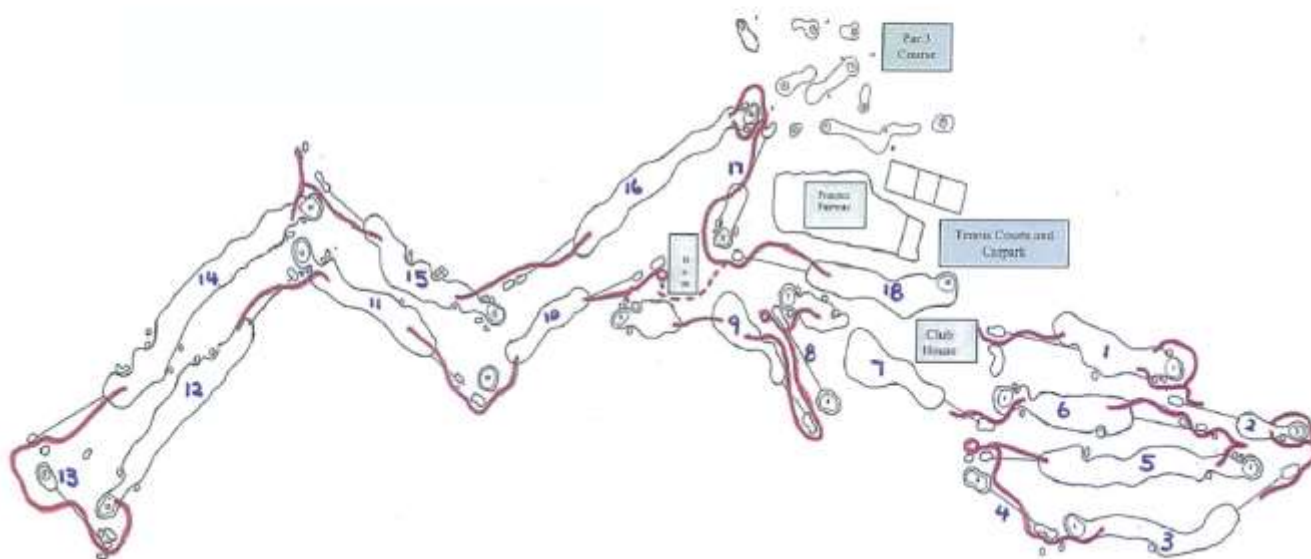
