CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

- Any entrant may withdraw and have their entry fee refunded prior notification is received not less than 3 working days prior to the commencement of the event. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded after this date unless players can provide supporting documents (medical certificates) regarding their withdrawal and will be at the sole discretion of the Match Committee of the Box Hill Golf Club.
- 3. Entries are restricted to Amateur Golfers who hold a Golf Australian handicap and who are Members of Clubs that are affiliated with or recognised by Golf Australia.
- 4. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place.
- 5. All protests or disputes shall be dealt with by the Match Committee of the Box Hill Golf Club, whose decision will be final, and any such protest or dispute must be lodged in **writing** with the Match Committee within **30 minutes** from time of return of the final competitor's score card.
- 6. The Match Committee of the Box Hill Golf Club shall have the <u>entire</u> management of the tournament and full power to alter or vary these conditions (except clauses 3, 4 & 6) and any handicap divisions at their discretion.
- 7. The Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten any competition or postpone it to another day.
- 8. Competitors shall be drawn to play in such manner as the Match Committee arranges and must be prepared to play when called upon.
- 9. In the event of a tie in the Gross and Handicap events, the winner will be decided by the Golf Australian approved count back method.
- 10. Dress Rules

Male – On Course:

- > Golf attire which should be neat, clean, comfortable and appropriate to the conditions.
- > Trousers and shorts must be of a style designed to be worn with a belt and have a zipper.
- > Shirts which are collarless must be golf specific.
- Shirts may be worn loose and not tucked in.
- Socks/Sockettes when worn with shorts (or other clothing that renders the socks or sockettes visible) must be predominantly white. If long socks are worn with shorts, then they must be pulled up and secured.
- > All hats must be worn as intended by their manufacturers design.
- Soft Spiked golf shoes only.

Female – On Course:

- As above
- Appropriate skirt for golf
