INTERNATIONAL BOWL | Terms of the Competition

Overview

The International Bowl competition is open to all female golfers who hold a GA handicap and who are members of a club affiliated with Golf Australia (South Australia).

The competition is 18 holes stroke-play (nett) in two divisions run and managed by the club held between 2nd March and 3rd August 2020. *Three (3)* rounds should be nominated by the Club during this time to ensure that players can submit up to three (3) rounds.

The handicap divisions are as follows:

- Silver GA Handicap up to 18.4
- Bronze GA Handicap 18.5 to 45.4

*Please note maximum GA handicap is not to be extended beyond 45.4.

The lowest single nett score in relation to the <u>Playing Conditions Calculation (PCC)</u> of the course on the day of play determines the winners in each division at that club. In the event of a tie a count-back will apply.

Clubs may wish to hold events in conjunction with their nominated International Bowl rounds.

Entry Fee & Results

An entry fee of \$3.00 per player (includes GST) who participates in her Club event entitles her to return a card in up to three (3) nominated rounds.

Members of more than one club may compete at any club of which they are a member on payment of an entry fee at each club.

The winner and runner up details are to be completed on the attached entry form and forwarded with all entry fees to alicias@golf.org.au

No minimum number of entries required for each division.

Clubs must retain the winner and runner up scorecards for all divisions. In the event of a tie, Golf Australia require these cards to be forwarded for countback purposes. If a copy of the scorecard cannot be provided, the player(s) will not be considered.

Brooches

International Bowl brooches are available to clubs for presentation to the Club Winner of each division. These brooches are \$7.00 each (includes GST) and must be ordered on the completed remittance form.

Trophies

State winners in each division will be awarded a Golf Australia medallion and perpetual trophy.

Prize vouchers will be awarded to the winners of each district. Districts are as follows:

- Eyre Peninsula
- Metropolitan
- Mid North
- Murraylands & Riverland
- Northern
- South Eastern
- Southern

Perpetual trophies and medallions will be presented to State Winners at a date arranged between her Home Club and Golf Australia (SA). State Runners-Up and District Winners will have their prize posted to their Home Clubs once results have been finalised.

SHYLIE RYMILL FOURSOMES | Terms of the Competition

Overview

This event is to honour the late Mrs H L Rymill, the co-founder of the SALGU (South Australian Ladies Golf Union) in 1925.

The Shylie Rymill Foursomes competition is open to all female golfers who hold a GA handicap and who are members of a club affiliated with Golf Australia (South Australia).

The competition is played as handicap foursomes. *One (1)* round of 18 holes should be scheduled at Club Level between 2nd March – 3rd August 2020. The winning pair will record the lowest nett score in relation to the <u>scratch rating</u>.

Maximum individual GA handicap is not to be extended beyond 45.4.

Each pair's handicap should be half of their combined individual <u>daily</u> handicaps. Please ensure that both the combined handicap and daily handicaps are shown on the scorecard.

The lowest nett score in relation to the <u>scratch rating</u> determines the winning pair in each division at Club Level. In the event of a tie a count-back will apply.

Clubs may wish to hold events in conjunction with their nominated Shylie Rymill Foursomes round.

Entry Fee & Results

Entry fee of \$3.00 per pair (includes GST).

Members of more than one club may compete at any club of which they are a member on payment of an entry fee at each club.

The winner and runner up names and details are to be completed on the attached entry form and forwarded with all entry fees to alicias@golf.org.au

No minimum number of entries required for each division.

Clubs must retain the winner and runner up scorecard. In the event of a tie, Golf Australia require these cards to be forwarded for countback purposes. If a copy of the scorecard cannot be provided, the player(s) will not be considered.

Brooches

Shylie Rymill Foursomes brooches are available to clubs for presentation to the Club Winners of each division. These brooches are \$14.00 per pair (inc. GST) and must be ordered on the completed remittance form.

Trophies

State winners in each division will be awarded a Golf Australia medallion and perpetual trophy.

Perpetual trophies and medallions will be presented to State Winners at a date arranged between the Home Club and Golf Australia (SA). State Runners-Up will have their prize posted to their Home Club once results have been finalised.

LAUREL WREATH | Terms of the Competition

Overview

This event was introduced in 1926 to encourage match play competition at Club Level.

The competition is handicap match play contested on dates to be arranged by the Club. There must be eight (8) or more entries in the competition. One division only.

Maximum individual GA handicap is not to be extended beyond 45.4. Daily handicaps on day of each match to be used.

Entry Fee & Results

Entry fee of \$3.00 per player (includes GST).

Members of more than one club may compete at any club of which they are a member on payment of an entry fee at each club.

Results do not need to be provided to Golf Australia, however entry numbers must be completed on the attached entry form and forwarded with all entry fees to alicias@golf.org.au

Brooches

One (1) Laurel Wreath brooch will be provided to Clubs free of charge providing that the minimum number of entries is achieved.

Other Information

ENTRY FEES, COMPLETED RESULTS & REMITTANCE FORMS MUST BE RECEIVED BY GOLF AUSTRALIA NO LATER THAN MONDAY 3RD AUGUST 2020.

If these have not been received by the closing date of entries, the results will not be eligible for overall or district prizes. No late entries will be accepted.
