PLAYER INFORMATION



FORMAT

The event is to be played over 18 holes stroke (h'cap up to 20) and 18 holes Stableford (h'cap 21+) and is open to Amateurs who are members of an affiliated Golf Club, have an official Golf Australia handicap and are under 18 years of age as at 1 January, 2020. Entries shall only be made via the Golf Australia Website unless otherwise permitted by the Tournament Committee.

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event. In the event of inclement weather or for any other reason, the Tournament Committee may shorten the event or arrange an alternate day. Protests must be made to the Tournament Committee no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of the round. The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final in all matters relating to the event. If any dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final. In addition, all players are required to adhere to Golf Australia's Code of Conduct for the duration of the Tournament.

REGISTRATION

All players are advised that registration will be available from **11.00am** in the Members Lounge of the **Clubhouse**, all players are requested to report to the desk by **no later than 12pm** to be allocated scorecards, course map & a copy of the Temporary Local Rules. There will be a pre-game briefing at 12.30am on the putting green and play will commence via a siren start at **12.45pm**.

CANCELLATIONS

If any person is unable to play, they are requested to notify the Golf Club on (03) 5991 3400 or email - proshop@cranbournegolf.com.au. No refunds will be given for cancellations within 72 hours of the event.

SCORE CARDS

Scorecards will be allocated at registration and are required to be returned to the **Pro Shop** immediately following play.

DRESS REGULATIONS

Please note there are some basic dress requirements that must be adhered to. Collared shirts are a must, shorts & pants should be tailored or belted (no cargo's or elasticised waists), white socks or black ankle socks are allowed, and please wear golf shoes. No denim at the Club.

COURSE REGULATIONS

All players are requested to observe and follow the following course regulations:-

- Sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used by each player.
- Players/caddies must rake all bunkers smoothly as exiting, and return rakes to the designated **rake holders**. If no holder is present, please return to middle of the bunker facing the direction of play.
- All pitch marks must be repaired.
- Play will be from the blue tee markers for boys and red tee markers for girls.
- Distance Measuring Devices (GPS) are permitted to be used at Cranbourne as per Local Rules.

Any player not complying with these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with GA's Code of Conduct.

SLOW PLAY

Rule 5.6 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

SUSPENSION OF PLAY

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Tournament Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play. The signal for suspending play will be one long siren blast. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6E. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations.

PULL BUGGIES

A limited number of pull buggies will be available to hire from the Pro Shop, however players are encouraged to bring their own buggies on the day.

PRACTICE BALLS

Practice balls are available for purchase from the Pro Shop for use on our full length practice range or short game area.

A competitor is not eligible to win more than one 18 HOLE EVENT. In the event of a tie, there will be a count back as per Golf Australia regulations.
