



# 2020 SOUTH AUSTRALIAN PRIMARY SCHOOLS GOLF EVENT – CONDITIONS

## 1. Format

- i. The event has two sections (qualifying and state final). All students will compete in a 9-hole qualifying event with qualifying students to progress to the state final - Day 1 - 15 holes and Day 2 - 18 holes
- ii. Students who qualify to the state final will be notified of their progression on the day of their qualifying event. A maximum of 10 students with the lowest scores (including a minimum 2 females) from each Sapsasa District will qualify making a total of 160 for the State Final.
- iii. In the event of a tie for the State Championship, a sudden death hole by hole play-off will be conducted (as decided by the Match Committee). Ties for other place getters will be decided by countback.

## 2. Eligibility

- i. Boys & Girls in grade 5, 6 or 7 who are aged 10 years and over as at 31 Dec 2020.
- ii. Students who are in year 4 and meet the above age criteria and have some experience playing golf may seek permission to participate from Golf Australia.
- iii. Students **do not** require a golf handicap to compete.

## 3. Entries

- i. Entries for the qualifying events close with Golf Australia 7 days before the advertised date or when a capacity field has been reached. Entries are taken online at the Golf Australia website.
- ii. Register via > [www.golf.org.au](http://www.golf.org.au) > Go to the 'Events & Results' tab > under the 'Competitions' tab | select 'National Events Calendar' | select the location as 'South Australia' | under category select '11. School Events' | Find your qualifier and register.
- iii. Students are only allowed to compete in one qualifier.

## 4. Trophies

- i. Prizes will be awarded at the state final only.
- ii. In the event of tie in each of the categories the Golf Australia count-back system shall be used to determine final positions. If scores are still tied, then positions will be awarded to the tied players.

## 5. Championship Committee

- i. The Championship Committee shall consist of representatives of Golf Australia and School Sport SA. The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event. Protests must be made to the Championship Committee no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of each round. The decision of the Championship Committee will be the final in all matters relating to the tournament.

- ii. The tournament organiser may in the event of severe weather or for any other reason either shorten the tournament or appoint another day or days for completion of event.

## 6. Publicity & Promotion

- i. Golf Australia and School Sport SA may arrange for photographs and videos of players, caddies and spectators during all rounds of this event. These images may be used on social media and website content to promote the event. In entering this event the player and parents understand that Golf Australia and School Sport SA retain the right to use images taken during this event. If a player wishes for their image not to be used please contact Golf Australia.
- ii. All results will be published on the Golf Australia website. In entering this event the player understands that their name and school will be published on the tournament results sheet which is displayed on the website. If a player wishes not for their name and school to be published on the website, they will need to contact Golf Australia prior.

## 7. Database of Competitors Details

- i. The personal data contained in this entry is permanently retained by Golf Australia. This data may be utilised by Golf Australia or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent entry forms, event literature, the Golf Australia e-newsletter, or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of Golf Australia events, or information about events conducted by Golf Australia approved bodies. Upon receipt by Golf Australia of written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.

## 8. Standard Event Conditions

- i. The event conditions are to be read in conjunction with the standard conditions for Golf Australia events, and the general conditions of competition for School Sport SA events. Where there is any inconsistency between the standard conditions and those set out above, the conditions above will prevail.

## 9. Code of Conduct

- i. All entrants are bound by Golf Australia's and School Sport SA's code of conduct.
