## CALLIOPE JUNIOR OPEN 2020 Conditions of Play

#### Tournament Committee

The tournament committee shall have the sole management and control of the event. The committee consists of members and volunteers of the Calliope Junior Golf Club.

The championship committee reserve the right to:

- a) In the event of bad weather or for any other reason, either shorten the contest or fix another date/venue
- b) Vary the conditions should they deem it advisable
- c) Reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore
- d) Change conditions of categories for Girls and Boys subjects to nominations
- e) Fix/alter the starting times

The decision of the championship committee will be final in all matters and in the absence of a full committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any such decision shall be deemed to be a decision of a full tournament committee.

#### **Course Marshals**

A course marshal may carry out spot checks on all players score cards during a round of the event and has the right to issue penalties for slow play. Slow play is deemed as losing one or more fairways with no acceptable reason.

#### **Players**

- 1. All juniors must be a financial member of a member club, affiliated with Golf Queensland and play off their correct Golf Australia or Club handicap.
- 2. Any player who disrupts play, abuses the course of behaves in a manner not becoming to the etiquette of gold may be penalised or disqualifies from the competition.
- 3. Any player deliberately cheating will automatically be disqualified and name recorded.
- 4. Remember proper golf etiquette, please show respect by not talking, moving or making unnecessary noise when another player is taking their shot, especially on the tee block and putting green.
- 5. Follow the Rues of Golf and please read the local rules before play.
- 6. All players must play off handicaps within Central Queensland regulations or not be eligible for gross prizes.
- 7. Each player is eligible for only one major prize.
- 8. Rangefinders/GPS devices are allowed for use by players in the 18-hole events.

#### **Caddies**

Caddies of all competitors must not interfere with any other competitor during a round of the event, should a person have a concern about another competitor, that person should bring that concern to the marker of the competitor. Caddies remember proper golf etiquette, please show respect to players by not talking, moving or making unnecessary noise when another player is taking their shot, specially on the tee block and putting green. Caddies may assist in lining up only for 3, 6 and 9 hole players. 13 and 18 hole golfers are not permitted to have their caddy assist once they address the ball and will incur a one stroke penalty per occurrence and may be subject to disqualification.

#### **Mobile Phones**

Are permitted to be carried by players or caddies for safety reasons only and must be turned off or on silent during play. Any player or caddy of a player who receives an incoming call during play or sends a message or initiates a call during play may be penalised.

#### <u>Ties</u>

In the event of a tie in a gross winner event a play off will take place on a hole determined by the tournament committee. All other events will be decided by a count back on the Australian Count Back System. When a play off cannot take place a count back will take place.

#### Protests

All protests (incl. Caddies) must be lodged within 10 minutes of round completion to the tournament committee or Calliope Golf Club representative.

#### **Carts/Buggies**

No player or caddy is allowed to play in the tournament in a motorised golf cart/buggy unless given permission by the tournament committee/representative and a medical reason given.

#### Safety

All players must ensure that the entire group ahead (players, caddies, walkers) is clear before playing - this includes waiting until the group has had their second shot when waiting on the tee, and ensuring the group ahead is well clear of the green before approaching, no matter how far out from the green. When in doubt, wait. "Fore" shall be clearly called whenever a ball is hit towards any other people on the course.
