- Nearest the pin on par 3 holes
- Tee times will commence from 9:00am
- The entry fee for 18-hole events is \$30, which includes lunch and a drink

- No handicap is required for these events
- Trophies will be awarded to the gross winner and runner up in each event
- Tee times will commence from 10:00am
- The entry fee for 9-hole events is \$20, which includes lunch and a drink

- 1. AGE ELIGIBILITY: Players under the age of 18 as at Tuesday 19th January 2021.
- **2. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:** The Ballarat District Golf Junior Development Committee shall have the entire management responsibility for the tournament.
- **3. ENTRIES:** Entries into events 1, 2, 3 and 4 are restricted to amateurs who are current members of clubs affiliated with Golf Australia or of golf clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League. The Tournament Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- **4. NUMBER OF ENTRIES:** The Tournament Committee shall have the authority to limit the number of entries accepted.
- 5. TEE TIMES: Players must report to the starter 15 minutes prior to their tee time and be prepared to hit off when called upon. Tee times will be emailed to all players and be available at www.bdga.com.au on Saturday 16th January.
- 6. RULES: The tournament shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, together with such local rules that are in force at the time of the competition. Disputes shall be decided by the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final. Any such dispute must be made in writing to the Tournament Committee no later than 15 minutes after the completion of play.
- **7. CADDIES:** All players competing in events 1, 2, 3 and 4 must transport their own clubs unless special arrangements have been made with the Tournament Committee.
- 8. TIES: In the event of a tie in the gross category of events 1, 2, 3 and 4, a playoff will be conducted to determine the winner. In all other events and categories, the final placings shall be determined on count-back, under the system recommended by Golf Australia.
- **9. TROPHIES:** A minimum of five players will be required for trophies to be awarded for a specific age/gender group. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to redefine age/gender groups should insufficient entries be received. A player winning a trophy in a gross event/s is ineligible to win a trophy in a net event. A player may only win one net event trophy.
- **10. WEATHER PROVISION:** The Tournament Committee may in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason either shorten the tournament or postpone it to another day.
- 11. DRESS CODE: All players will be made honorary members of the Midlands Golf Club for the duration of the tournament. Dress standards will apply to all players and spectators whilst on the course or in the clubhouse.
- 12. DATABASE OF PLAYER DETAILS: The data contained on an entry form submitted by a player for the Ballarat Junior Classic is retained by Ballarat District Golf within its database. This database is operated to assist with the management of current and future Ballarat District Golf events. From time to time players may be sent entry forms or event literature. Upon receipt of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
